5 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFORE, and the parties' having stipulated to the
6 in part
7 same, the Court hereby APPROVES the Parties' Joint Stipulation to Reopen Discovery,
8 Extend Time to File Dispositive Motions, and Continue Trial Date as follows:

- 9 1. Discovery shall be reopened until February 28, 2020, to allow Plaintiff to
10 conduct additional discovery necessary to sufficiently explore the new
11 information contained in Defendants' production on December 16, 2019 as
12 ordered by Magistrate Judge Illman, (Dkt. 152) (the "Recent Production"), and
13 the reason for Defendants' failure to timely produce all relevant documents and
14 communications.
- 15 2. Plaintiff shall be allowed to further review the Recent Production and depose
16 for a reasonable amount of time any Defendant or third-party witness implicated
17 by the Recent Production;
- 18 3. The deadline to file Dispositive Motions shall be extended from January 10,
19 2020, to March 10, 2020;
- 20 4. The deadline to file Oppositions to Dispositive Motions shall be extended from
21 January 24,
22 ~~January 17,~~ 2020, to March 24, 2020;
- 23 5. The deadline to file Replies shall be extended from January 31, 2020, to March
24 31, 2020; and

26 6. The trial date shall be continued from April 20, 2020 to June 22, 2020. is
27 vacated and will be reset at a Status Conference to be conducted March
6, 2020, at 10:30 a.m.

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7. A Joint Status Report Statement shall be filed no later than February 28, 2020.
